In 1989 Kettle Brand[®] began operation of a sister factory in Norwich, United Kingdom, selling Kettle Brand[®] products throughout Western Europe and Asia. In 2007, it opened its second U.S. production facility in Beloit, Wis. Kettle Brand[®]

employs more than 700 people.

Community Involvement: Hundreds of thousands of pounds of potatoes and thousands of

cases of Kettle Brand® product are donated to local hunger relief

agencies and nonprofit organizations each year.

Environmental Initiatives: Kettle Brand[®] backs its natural brand promise with a commitment

to sustainable business practices. They operate on the principle of coexisting in harmony with the environment. The company offsets 100% of its electricity use through the purchase of wind power energy. Additionally, its cooking oil is recycled into biodiesel that fuels a fleet of company cars. The original facility in Salem, Ore. is located adjacent to a restored wetland and the factory in Beloit is surrounded by five acres of prairie now returned to its native state.
